## Gentlemen:

We, the undersigned, respectfully request that our property be reclassified under the zoning ordinance as follows:

- The property consists of a tract containing eight (8) original lots on the southwesterly side of Belhaven Boulevard (N. C. Highway #16) between Honeywood Avenue and Nelson Avenue. The property for which the reclassification is requested has a depth of 150 feet from the edge of said Belhaven Boulevard.
- 2. The present zoning classification is R 6 MF.
- 3. The requested zoning classification is B-1.
- 4A. This change in zoning is requested because the property is no longer suitable for uses under the R 6 MF classification in that the character of the neighborhood has drastically changed:
  - a. The property is approximately 300 feet from the Interstate 85 and Highway 16 interchange.
  - b. Between the property in question and Interstate 85 the entire Highway 16 frontage is occupied by a large: service station. In fact there are large service stations existing or proposed for all four corners of the interchange.
  - c. Immediately adjacent to the property beyond Nelson Street towards the center of Charlotte lies an existing shopping center complete with A & P supermarket, etc. and slightly beyond is an oil distributorship.

- d. On the opposite side of Highway 16 is the proposed entrance of the access road for the new Northwest Expressway.
- e. Slightly more than one block in the southwesterly direction (behind the property) is the industrial area and business area along Mount Holly Road and the Seaboard Airline Railroad.
- f. There are no valuable homes in the neighborhood and much of the nearby property is presently unimproved or is vacant and dilapidated.
- 4B. The B-l classification would make it possible for this property to be used either in an expansion of the adjacent shopping center or for the creation for additional facilities for the servicing of members of the transit public who may be expected in large numbers in and around the major interchange.

A plat of the environment is attached complete with measurements.
