Purpose of Change: Proposed Amendments to the City's UDC-V Ordinance to Make it Like the County's UDC-V Ordinance

Action Requested: Planning Commission concurrence to place the attached City Zoning Ordinance Amendments on the next public hearing agenda. (March 21)

Background: The City approved the UDC-V Ordinance at their December 20, 1982 meeting. They made one minor change in the proposal. The County approved the UDC-V Ordinance at their January 4, 1983 meeting. In addition to incorporating the change made by the City, they made six other changes in the original proposal. These dealt with:

- emphasizing the anti-strip development intent of the ordinance.
- encouraging, though not requiring, access from two thoroughfares instead of just one.
- emphasizing the advisory status of the 2.5 mile separation between UDC-V's but also noting its applicability even between sites separated by municipal boundaries.
- encouraging nearby property owners to work cooperatively rather than competitively toward securing UDC-V sites.
- adding clarifying language regarding limitations on hotel sizes.
- adding clarifying language regarding which development standards could be modified.

The effect of these changes will be to make the City and County ordinances parallel with regard to the UDC-V issue. We are moving toward completely parallel ordinances as a result of our recodification effort.
