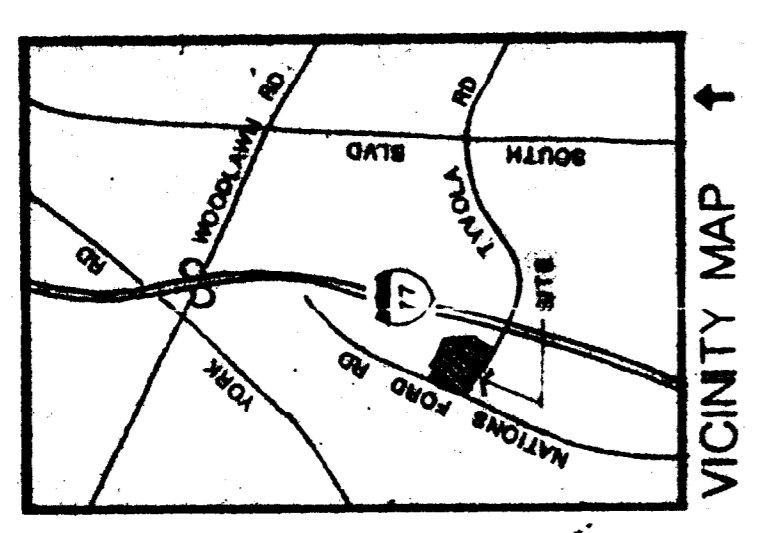

SIGNAGE ZONE
Area of signage as allowed by ordinance.
Monument type signage only. 10' maximum height above grade at sign location or above corresponding elevation of roadway, whichever is greater.

SIGNAGE ZONE
Maximum of 30 sq. ft. of image area per location.

Maximum of 30 sq. ft. of image area per location.

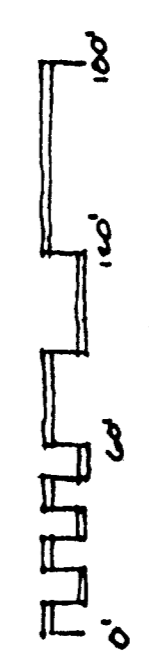
EXISTING TREES TO REMAIN.

LANDSCAPE NOTES:

- The location shown are schematic only and show the intent of the design. Exact locations to be determined in the field.
- Deciduous and evergreen trees to supplement existing trees in buffer. Deciduous trees to be 2 1/2" - 3" (min.) caliper and evergreen trees to be 2" - 2 1/2" caliper and include: pines and hollies.
- Tree planting to enhance screening along masonry wall. Small to medium size flowering trees to be planted along wall with additional larger trees and existing trees planted behind wall. Tree species to include: Kousa Dogwood, Magnolia, or Yoshino cherry, apricot, and flowering crabapple.
- Existing trees to remain. Tree protection to be provided during construction, including watering and pruning.
- Canopy trees to be 2 1/2" - 3" caliper and planted as shown. Tree species to include: oak, maple, Bradford pear and alders.
- Typical entrance planting to accent entrance and highlight the building. Planting to include: pines and hollies.
- Exact location of storm water detention facility may vary subject to final grading plan, method of detention and/or location of flowway.
