Establish zoning jurisdiction of the City of

Charlotte and newly annexed areas.

LOCATION:

Approximately 6,276 acres located in five areas which

were annexed in the City of Charlotte effective

June 30, 1989.

ACTION:

The Zoning Committee recommends that this petition be

approved.

REASONS

The City of Charlotte is authorized by State law to extend its zoning jurisdiction into newly annexed areas. It is common practice for the City of Charlotte to establish zoning on properties in newly annexed areas as the same zoning categories as the properties contained when they were under the jurisdiction of Mecklenburg County. Within these five annexation areas there are two exceptions to this rule. I-77 Corridor North Annexation Area there are several parcels which are zoned 0-9. This is a category which does not exist in the City ordinance. The recommendation for these parcels is that they be zoned 0-6 under the City Zoning Ordinance so that no nonconforming uses would be created. The other exception to the customary practice is a small parcel of land in the Rea Road/Elm Lane West annexation area. parcel is zoned RU(CD) for a commercial nursery. The City Zoning Ordinance does not contain a similar category and the property owners. have consented to their site being rezoned to B-1(CD) pursuant to the site plan originally approved by Mecklenburg County. The Zoning Committee believes that this addresses all of the concerns of property owners involved in the annexation and makes a smooth transition from County zoning jurisdiction to City zoning jurisdiction. Committee recommends that this petition be approved.

STAFF OPINION

The staff agrees with the recommendation of the Zoning Committee.
