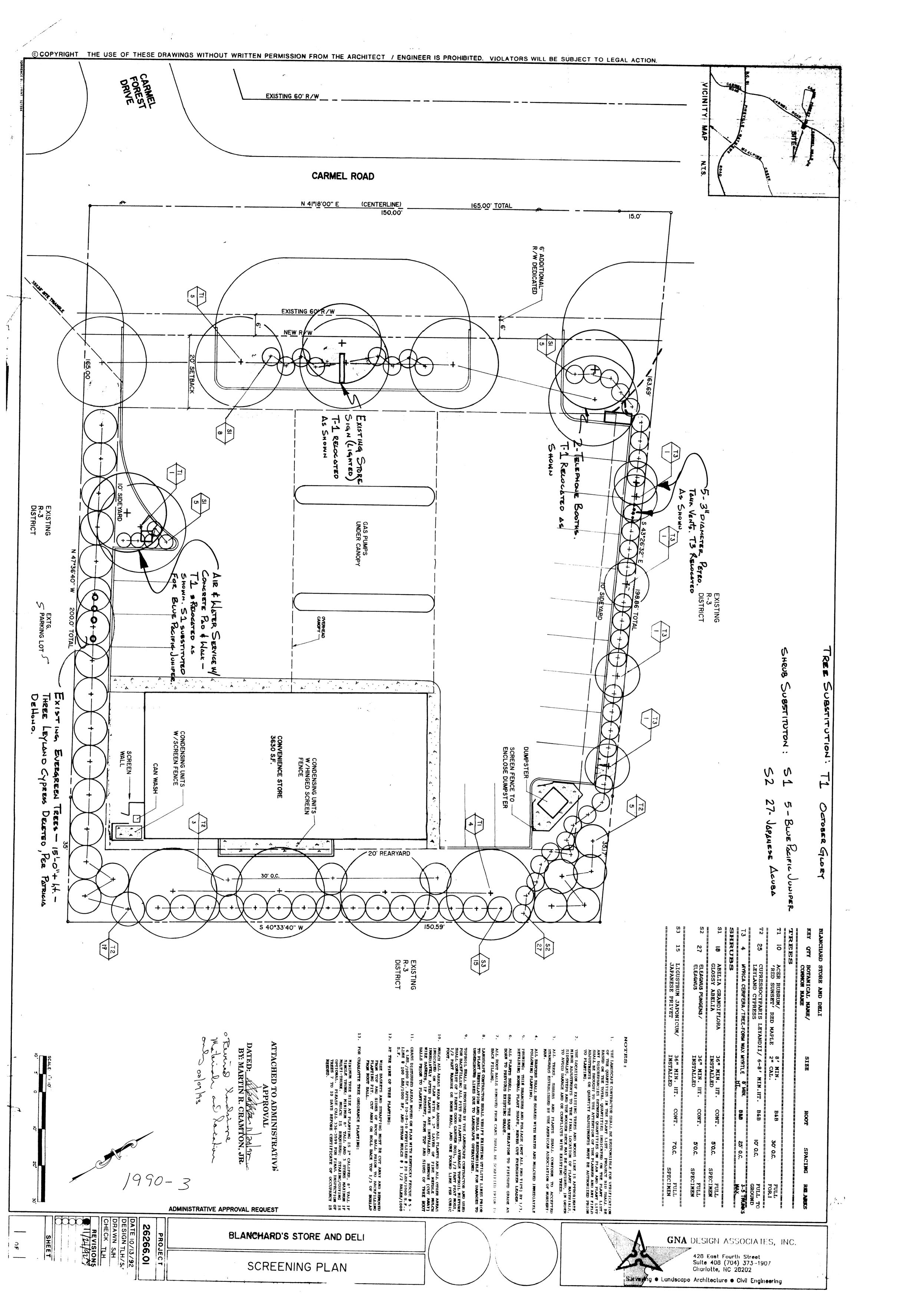
- Increase the length of the area set aside for condensing units.

- To add an air and water pump along the northern face of the building.

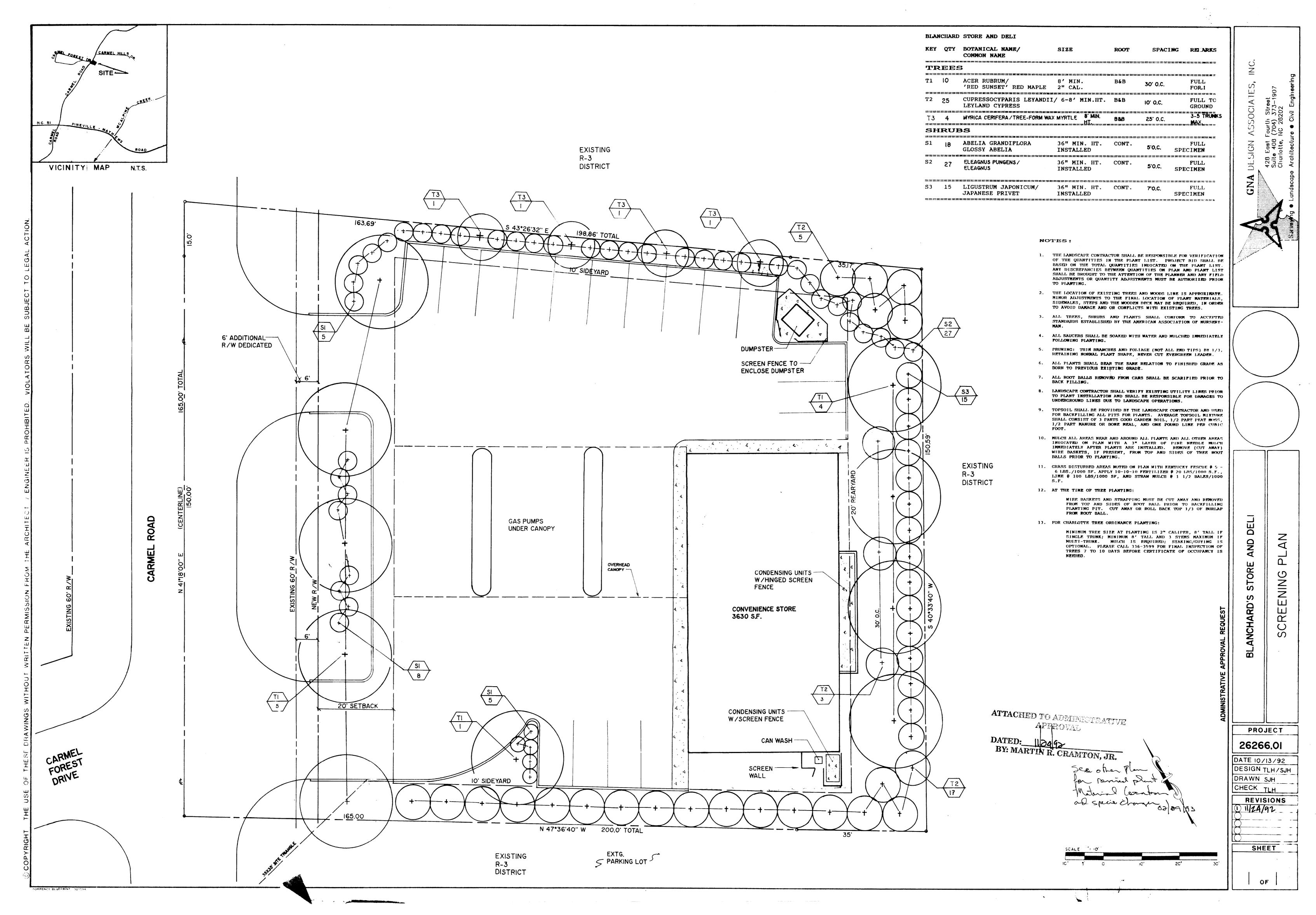
Since these changes are minor in nature and do not intensify the site, I am administratively approving this plan. Please use this plan when evaluating requests for building permits and certificates of occupancy.

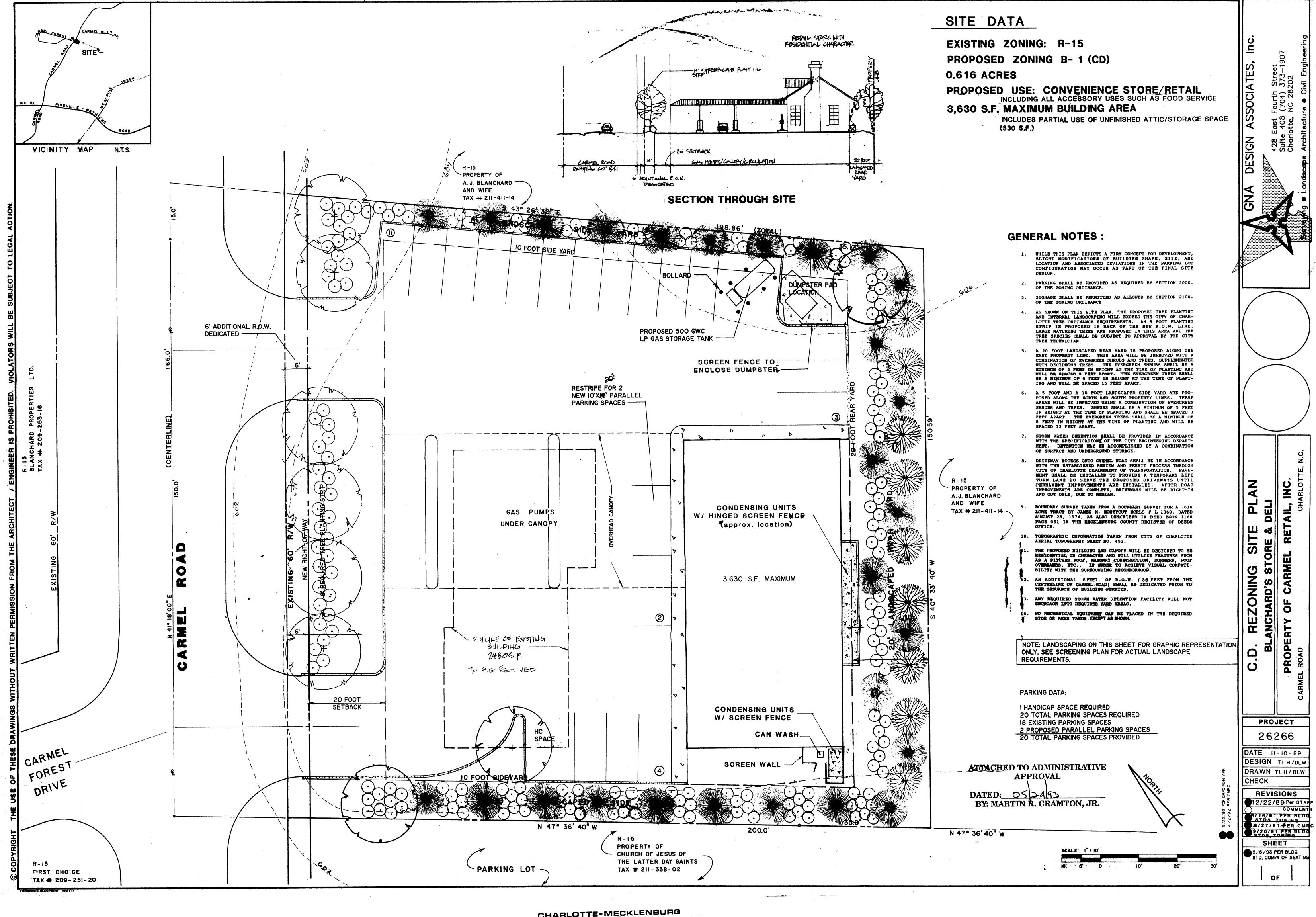

Attached is a revised plan for the above mentioned rezoning petition. The plan has been revised to show the addition of a propane tank service area along the northern property line adjacent to the existing dumpster. The installation of this propane tank will eliminate two existing parking spaces which the owner will replace by adding two parallel spaces at the front of the store.

The owner has also acknowledged that six seats of the existing thirty-six in the deli will be removed so the site will comply with the required number of parking spaces.

Since this change is minor and does not effect the yards at the exterior of the property I am administratively approving this plan. Please use this plan when evaluating requests for building permits and certificates of occupancy.
