



Unapproved principal uses:

- Buses and train terminals.
- Civic, social service or fraternal facilities.
- Cemeteri
- Any medical clinic or laboratory other than a dental clinic or laboratory, optical clinic or laboratory or chiropractor clinic or laboratory.
- Any veterinary clinic which provides extended boarding facilities.
- Cultural facilities
- Dwellings
- Funeral homes, embalming and crematories.
- Elementary and secondary schools.
- Health institutions.
- Indoor recreation, as a principal use.
- . Power chan
- Pinball machine establishments.
- Video games establishments.
- Precious metal establishments.

- Gunsmiths and gun repair shop.
- Recycling centers, drop-off.

- Religious institutions.
- Check cashing establishments.
- Coin operated laundries.
- Outside telephone booths. This exclusion is not intended to prevent the installation
 of up to one exterior wall mounted telephone on each building constructed on the
 site.
- Outdoor seasonal sales, unless made by the operator of an establishment located on the Site as an incidental or accessory use to the primary business.
- Adult care centers.
- Adult care homes.
- Boarding stables.
- Car wash establishments. This is not intended to exclude the operation, as an
 incidental or accessory use, if the equipment involves a coin operated single bay
 car wash machine.
- Child care centers and child care homes, unless operated or sponsored by a national
 or regional organization or by any other organization which is operating at least
 four child care centers within Mecklenburg County at the time of the issuance of
 the permit authorizing its use.

- Nightclubs, bars and lounges.
- Nursing homes, rest homes and homes for the agad.
- Open space recreational uses.
- Orphanages, children's homes and similar non-profit institutions providing domiciliary care for children.
- Outdoor recreation.

- Planned multi-family and attached development.
- Public utility structures, other than those required to deliver the normal and necessary utility services to the Site.
- Public utility transmission and distribution lines, unless already installed on the Site.
- Radio, telephone, cellular telephone and television masts, towers, antennae and similar structures.
- Group homes.

Unapproved accessory uses or structures:

- Any accessory use which is not clearly incidental to the principal use and any accessory structure which is not substantially similar to the main structure which
- Customary home occupations.
- Elderly and disabled housing.
- Guest houses and employee quarters.
- Helistops.
- Marin
- On-site demolition landfills.
- Private kennel.
- Outdoor vending machines other than wall mounted telephones.
- The outside storage of tires or motor vehicles awaiting repair service.

Drive-Through Service - No drive-through services may be provided by any restaurant establishment that might locate on the Site, the intent being to prohibit drive-through services, whether as a principal use or an accessory use, in connection with any restaurant use.
