


SITE DATA / GENERAL NOTES:

1. EXISTING ZONING: R-17MF(CD), PETITION NUMBER 99-36 FRONT SETBACK: 30' REAR YARD: 501



- 3. PIPE SYSTEMS AND OPEN CHANNELS WITHIN PUBLIC STORM DRAINAGE EASEMENTS ARE THE MAINTENANCE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE
- 4. ALL EASEMENTS (DRIVEWAYS, DRAINS, OR UTILITIES) TO BE SHOWN BY METES AND BOUNDS DESCRIPTION ON THE FINAL PLAT.
- 5. ALL CONSTRUCTION TO BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CHARLOTTE-MECKLENBURG LAND DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS MANUAL.
- 6. ON-SITE BURIAL PITS ("STUMP HOLES") REQUIRE AN ON-SITE DEMOLITION LANDFILL PERMIT FROM THE ZONING
- 7. THIS PROJECT TO COMMENCE ON: JUNE 1, 2000 AND BE COMPLETED ON: NOVEMBER 1, 2000
- 8. DEVELOPER WILL PROVIDE STREET SIGNS AS PER CHARLOTTE/MECKLENBURG LAND DEVELOPMENT STANDARD NO. 50.05A.
- 9. IN ROLLING AND HILLY TERRAIN, SWEEPING OF THE STONE BASE AND/OR APPLICATION OF A TACK COAT MAY BE REQUIRED NEAR INTERSECTIONS. THESE REQUIREMENTS WILL BE ESTABLISHED BY THE CITY INSPECTOR BASED ON FEILD CONDITIONS
- 10. NON-STANDARD ITEMS(ie: PAVERS IRRIGATION SYSTEMS, ETC.) IN THE RIGHT-OF-WAY REQUIRE A RIGHT-OF-WAY ENCROACHMENT AGREEMENT WITH THE CHARLOTTE DEPARTMENT
- II. LAND DEVELOPMENT ENGINEER TO BE GIVEN 24 HOURS NOTICE PRIOR TO START OF CONSTRUCTION.
- 12. APPROVAL OF THIS PLAN IS NOT AN AUTHORIZATION TO GRADE OF ADJACENT PROPERTIES. WHEN FEILD CONDITIONS WARRENT OFFSITE GRADING, PERMISSION MUST BE OBTAINED FROM THE AFFECTED PROPERTY
- 13. "AS-BUILT" DRAWINGS AND PLANS OF THE STORM DRAINAGE SYSTEM MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE CITY ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CHARLOTTE SUBDIVISION ORDINANCE.
- 14. IN ORDER TO ENSURE PROPER DRAINAGE, KEEP A MIN. OF 0.5% SLOPE ON THE CURB.
- 15. COORDINATE ALL CURB AND STREET GRADES IN INTERSECTION
- 16. THE DEVELOPER SHALL MAINTAIN EACH STREAM, CREEK, OR BACKWASH CHANNEL IN AN UNOBSTRUCTED STATE AND SHALL REMOVE FROM THE CHANNEL AND BANKS OF THE STREAM ALL DEBRIS, LOGS, TIMBER, JUNK AND OTHER ACCUMULATIONS.
- 17. REFER TO ARCHITECTURAL PLANS FOR BUILDING DIMENSIONS
- 18. ALL CURB RADIUS ARE TO BACK OF CURB.
- 19 CONTRACTOR SHALL PROTECT ALL ADJACENT PROPERTIES, THE GENERAL PUBLIC, AND ALL OTHER FACILITIES. SHOULD DAMAGES OCCUR, CONTRACTOR SHALL REPAIR IMMEDIATELY AS DIRECTED BY THE CROWN PROJECT ENGINEER. CONTRACTOR IS FINANCIALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL REPAIRS, AND REPAIRS ARE TO BE PERFORMED TO THE CROWN PROJECT ENGINEER'S SATISFACTION.
- 20. CONCRETE JOINTS OR SCORE MARKS ARE TO BE SHARP AND CLEAN WITHOUT SHOWING EDGES OF JOINTING TOOL.
- 21. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN THE SITE IN A MANNER SO THAT WORKMEN AND PUBLIC SHALL BE PROTECTED FROM INJURY.
- 22. THE CONTRACTOR IS SPECIFICALLY CAUTIONED THAT THE LOCATION AND PR 2. THE CONTRACTOR IS SPECIFICALLY CAUTIONED THAT THE LOCATION AND/ALL LEVATION OF EXISTING UTILITIES AS SHOWN ON THESE PLANS IS BASEF ON RECORDS OF THE VARIOUS UTILITY COMPANIES AND, WHERE POSSELE, MEASUREMENTS TAKEN IN THE FIELD. THE INFORMATION IS NOT TO BE RELIED ON AS BEING EXACT OR COMPLETE. THE CONTRACTOR MET CALL THE APPROPRIATE UTILITY COMPANY AT LEAST 72 HOURS BEFORE ANY TRENCHING OR EXCAVATION TO REQUEST EXACT FIELD LOCATION OF UTILITIES. FOR ASSISTANCE WITH FIELD LOCATION OF EXISTING UTILITIES THE
- 23. EXISTING CURB AND ASPHALT PAVEMENT SHALL BE SAWCUT.
- 24. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL REFER TO THE ARCHITETURAL PLAS FOR EXACT LOCATION OF THE UTILITY EXIT POINTS.
- 25. PROPERTY WAS REZONED FROM R-4 TO R-17MF(CD) BYETITION 99-36.
- 26. TRASH COLLECTION TO BE PROVIDED BY PRIVATE SERV
- 27. NO FACE OF THE PRIMARY STRUCTURE TO BE LOCATE WITHIN 15' OF THE
- 28. NO SIDE OF THE PRIMARY STRUCTURE TO BE LOCA! WITHIN 5' OF THE


