Purpose of Change:

To add a new subsection (9) entitled, Rail Transit Corridors. The purpose of this subsection is to protect specific rail corridors and to encourage them to serve as multi-modal transportation facilities, such as rail-trolley, bus, and pedestrian ways, while preserving the opportunity to add other transit related facilities in the future.

This amendment sets minimum setback and allowed uses in the setback for all property zoned UMUD along the rail right-of-way extending from I-277 (John Belk Freeway) to Twelfth Street lying between Brevard and College Streets.
