Sharon Towers Development Notes

1. The building configurations, placements, and sizes, as well as the parking areas, all of which are depicted on Sheet RZ-2 that accompanies this Technical Data Sheet are schematic in nature and may be altered and/or modified during design development and construction document phases as provided in Section 6.206. All square footages, number of units, and/or number of stories depicted on these rezoning documents, however will be the maximum allowed

2. The Petitioner agrees to dedicate to the City such additional right-of-way along it Sharon Road frontage as may be necessary to increase the right-of-way along it northwest side of the centerline to 50 (fifty) feet. This dedication shall occur prior to the issuance of any certificate of occupancy for any new development.

3. The existing secondary egress road that exits the site at a signalized intersection at Sharon View Road as shown on the Technical Data Sheet, shall remain in use in the general area depicted and will become the main, full movement access point to the site. The placement and configuration of each access point and driveway within the site are subject to any modifications required to accommodate the final site and architectural/engineering construction plans and designs and are further subject to approval by CDOT. The Petitioner reserves the right to relocate existing main access drive to the west to serve as a service drive subject to the approval of the CDOT. This driveway may be constructed prior to the closing of the existing main entrance so as to be used as a construction entrance. Upon completion of the construction and the improvement to the signalized driveway at Sharon View Rd, the Petitioner will close the existing main entrance drive and will plant a combination of trees and shrubs in place of the former drive to blend with the existing vegetation along Sharon Rd.

4. The setback, side yard, and rear yard requirements imposed under the Ordinance will be satisfied with respect to new development taking place within the Site. Structures existing within the side or rear yards and/or setbacks at the time of this Petition shall not be subject to any modification due to the yard and setback requirements.

5. Stormwater runoff will be managed through practices described in the City of Charlotte Storm Water Design Manual and approved by the City of Charlotte Engineering Department. No above ground detention or retention basins shall occur within any prescribed buffer or setback within the Site.

6. The parking areas depicted on Sheet RZ-2 may vary in size and location, but in all events, parking will meet the minimum standards established under the Ordinance (Section 12.202). Parking may be constructed inside of the parking envelope as depicted on Sheet RZ-1, and in no event shall parking take place in buffer or setback areas.

7. A lighting system will be employed to service the new buildings which is consistent with that already existing on the Site. All new direct lighting within the property shall be designed such that direct illumination does not extend past the property lines. Consideration will be given to the impact of lighting both within and without the perimeter of the site. The maximum height of freestanding lighting fixtures within the development will not exceed that the existing freestanding fixtures. No "wal pak" type light fixtures will be used on the new building.

8. All new signs placed on the property will be erected in accordance with the Ordinance. 9. Plans for each building will be submitted to the Charlotte Fire Department for approval before the construction of that building commences. Fire hydrants will be located within the prescribed locations under the Charlotte Mecklenburg Fire Code. All designated "Fire Lanes"

constructed as part of this development within the site will be at least 20' in width. 10. All dumpster areas will be screened in accordance with requirements of the Ordinance. Each dumpster area will be enclosed on all four sides by a fence and a hinged gate which are constructed of brick, wood, masonry, or any combination thereof unless one or more side of the dumpster area joins the rear of a building. In this case, the rear wall will be substituted for the

fence along each such. 11. Subject to the approved variance noted below, exterior buffer areas for all new development will be provided as required by Section 12.302 of the Ordinance, except that the Petitioner will not be allowed to decrease the required buffer. All designated buffer areas are to remain as undisturbed open space, except to the extent necessary to accommodate walls, fences, drainage structures, utility lines, sidewalks, and drives as prescribed within the Ordinance. Those structures currently existing at the time of this petition which encroach within the buffer areas depicted on the Technical Data Sheet of this petition shall not be subject to any modification due to the proposed buffer, nor shall buffer requirements be intensified due to the presence of these structures. The Petitioner has received a variance from the Charlotte Board of ints relative to the standard buffer requirements noted above, said variance having been granted on 12/28/99, pursuant to a note approved as part of Petition 98-107.

12. Landscaping and screening for all new development shall, at a minimum, satisfy the requirements of Section 12.303the Ordinance. All new development will receive landscape and tree planting as required by the City of Charlotte Tree Ordinance. In addition, the Petitioner will plant new trees and shrubs in the 2 areas along the Sharon Rd. frontage when gaps in the tree cover presently exist. This planting will consist of a combination of trees and shrubs to blend with the existing vegetation along Sharon Rd. It is the intent of this provision to create a combination of vegetation that will mature to appear to be an uninterrupted continuation of the streetscape that exists along Sharon Rd. at the time of zoning approval.

13. Buffers around the site will be left in the condition that they are at present. The buffers in their present state predated the buffer requirements and were approved to remain as part of a variance previously granted on 12/28/99. If it is determined that an additional variance is required to clarify the existing yards that have been present for a number of years, then the Petitioner reserves the right to apply for such a variance. Further, the petitioner reserves the separate right to apply of a variance with regard to an existing single family structure at the southern comer of the site that is proposed to remain and to become a part of the overall Sharon Towers community. If a variance is determined to be required and for some reason is not approved, then the structure will be removed from the site. Any and all changes will be subject to the provisions of section 6.206(2).

14. The vegetation along the Sharon Rd. frontage will be maintained in its present condition, except in the areas of driveway construction, CDOT mandated site distance triangles, and along the portion of the site where the proposed parking structure is to be located. In order to construct the proposed parking structure, the Petitioner reserves the right to grade up to ten feet into the 40'setback. Any vegetation that is removed coincident to this grading will be replaced with a combination of trees and shrubs to blend with the existing vegetation along Sharon Rd. It is the intent of this provision to create a combination of vegetation that will mature to appear to be an uninterrupted continuation of the streetscape that exists along Sharon Rd, at the time of zoning approval. The petitioner reserves the right to plant specific screening materials on or along the proposed parking structure as part of this commitment.



If the Petitioner's Rezoning Petition is approved, the development program established under these Development Standards and the Technical Data Sheet shall, unless amended in the manner provided under Section 6.206(2) of the Ordinance, be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the Petitioner and each of the Owners and their respective heirs, devisees, personal representatives, successors in interest and assigns.
