

Stone as recorded in Deed Book 4641, Page 283 with the Mecklenburg County Registry of Deeds office, thence proceeding S. 24-04-01 W. 383.52 feet to an existing iron rod, thence proceeding S.59-08-47 E. 213.28 feet to an existing iron pin on a common corner with a parcel owned now or formerly by Angus W. Stone Family Ltd. Partnership III as recorded in Deed Book 6268, Page 881 with the Mecklenburg County Register of Deeds office, thence proceeding along a common property line with a parcel owned now or formerly by R & G Machinery, Inc., as recorded in Deed Book 5944, Page 869 with the Mecklenburg Register of Deeds office, S. 32-58-40 W. 391.72 feet to an existing iron pin on a common property corner with a parcel owned now or formerly by Barry V. Brown by will, as recorded in Deed Book 2578, Page 237 with the Mecklenburg Register of Deeds office, thence proceeding S. 32-25-00 W. 404.00 feet a point in the center of Oak Drive with a right-of-way of 60 feet, thence proceeding along said centerline N. 16-00-00 W. 577.00 feet to a point in the 100 foot rightof-way of Southern Railroad, thence proceeding in said right-of-way N. 33-43-50 E. 404 feet to a point within same right-of-way, thence proceeding N. 59-15-36 W. 18.61 feet to a point in the center of the 100 foot Southern Railroad right-of-way, thence proceeding N. 30-11-07-E. 392.67 feet to a point in the center of the 100 foot Southern Railroad right-of-way, thence proceeding N. 30-10-29 E. 113.35 feet to a point in the center of the 100 foot Southern Railroad right-of-way, thence proceeding N. 30-57-41 E. 199.89 feet to the point and place of BEGINNING as shown on a survey for John P.
