Dear Ms. Reman, I am sorry to hear about your recent collision with an e-scooter rider and I hope that you are okay. I can certainly appreciate your concerns about the scooters being ridden on sidewalks given the possibility of collisions like this occurring. I am particularly concerned as well when you say that you were struck by a "kid" riding one of the scooters, because no one under the age of 18 should be allowed to check out one of these shared scooters according the companies own restrictions (a valid driver's license is required to activate the scooter indicating the rider's age). I will share your incident report with the operators to verify this is working properly. Also, if this ever happens again, I would encourage you to get the name of the rider and the scooter ID #. But of course, hopefully it does not happened again. Lastly, just so you know, our City Council adopted an ordinance in January that allows the scooters to be ridden on sidewalks (same as bikes) outside of the CBD/congested pedestrian district. So I would encourage you to reach out to your council member if you are not happy with the results of this resolution, as we continue to evaluate the outcome of our transition from the one-year pilot program into a more definitive, long-term Shared Mobility Program.

Thank you for taking the time to reach out to me regarding the visually impaired gentleman that was struggling to travel through the area of Stonewall and Tryon due to scooters yesterday at lunch time. I am going to ask Tracy Van Tassell (by copy of this e-mail) to follow up with you to get more details and to see if we could contact the gentleman. We are currently working with the scooter companies (that was part of the CBJ article topic) regarding improving parking location and behavior. While many scooter users are parking their scooters appropriately, there are some that are not and that is an issue that we are grappling with. Thanks again for making us aware of the situation you witnessed and Tracy will follow up with you to get more details.
