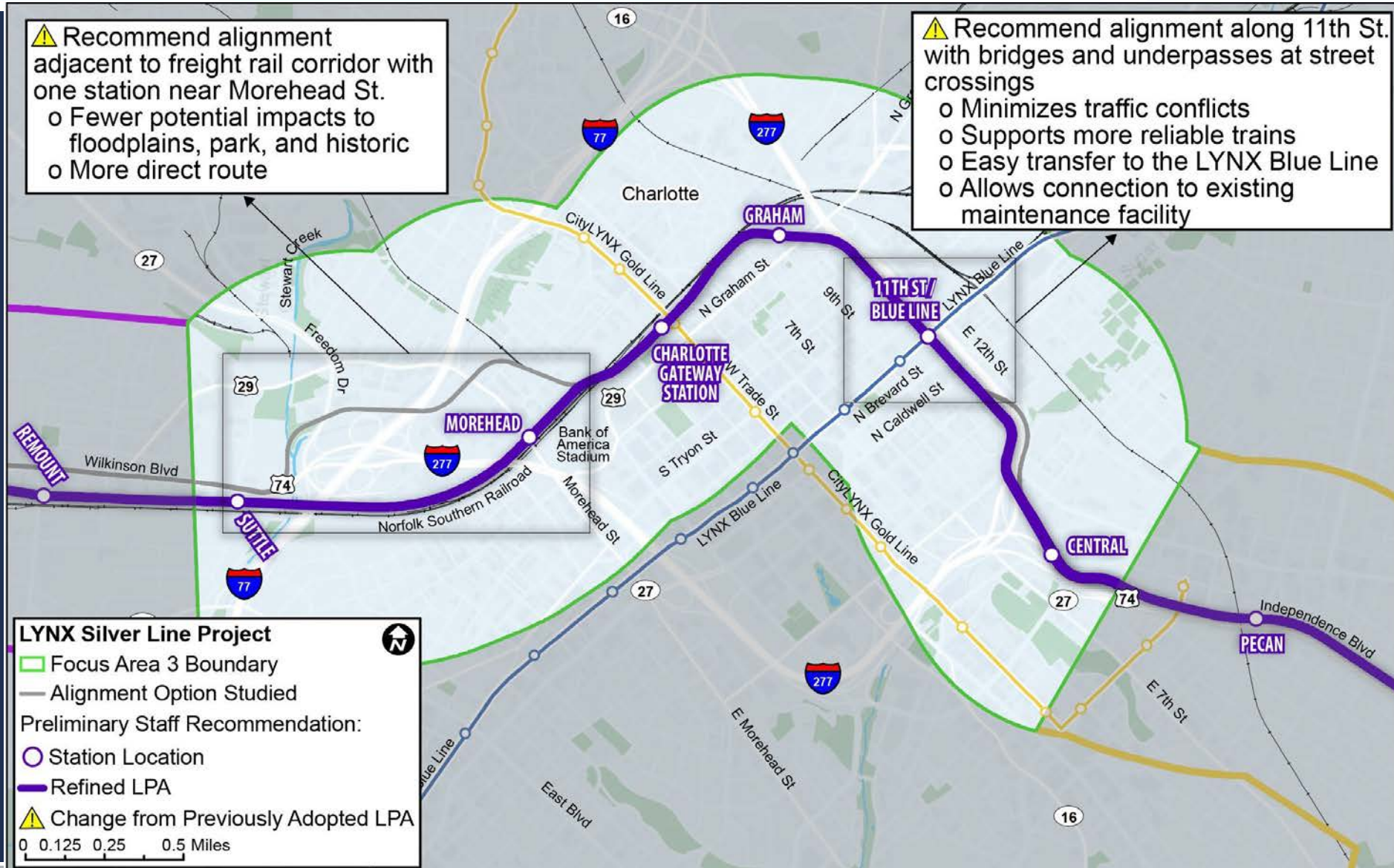

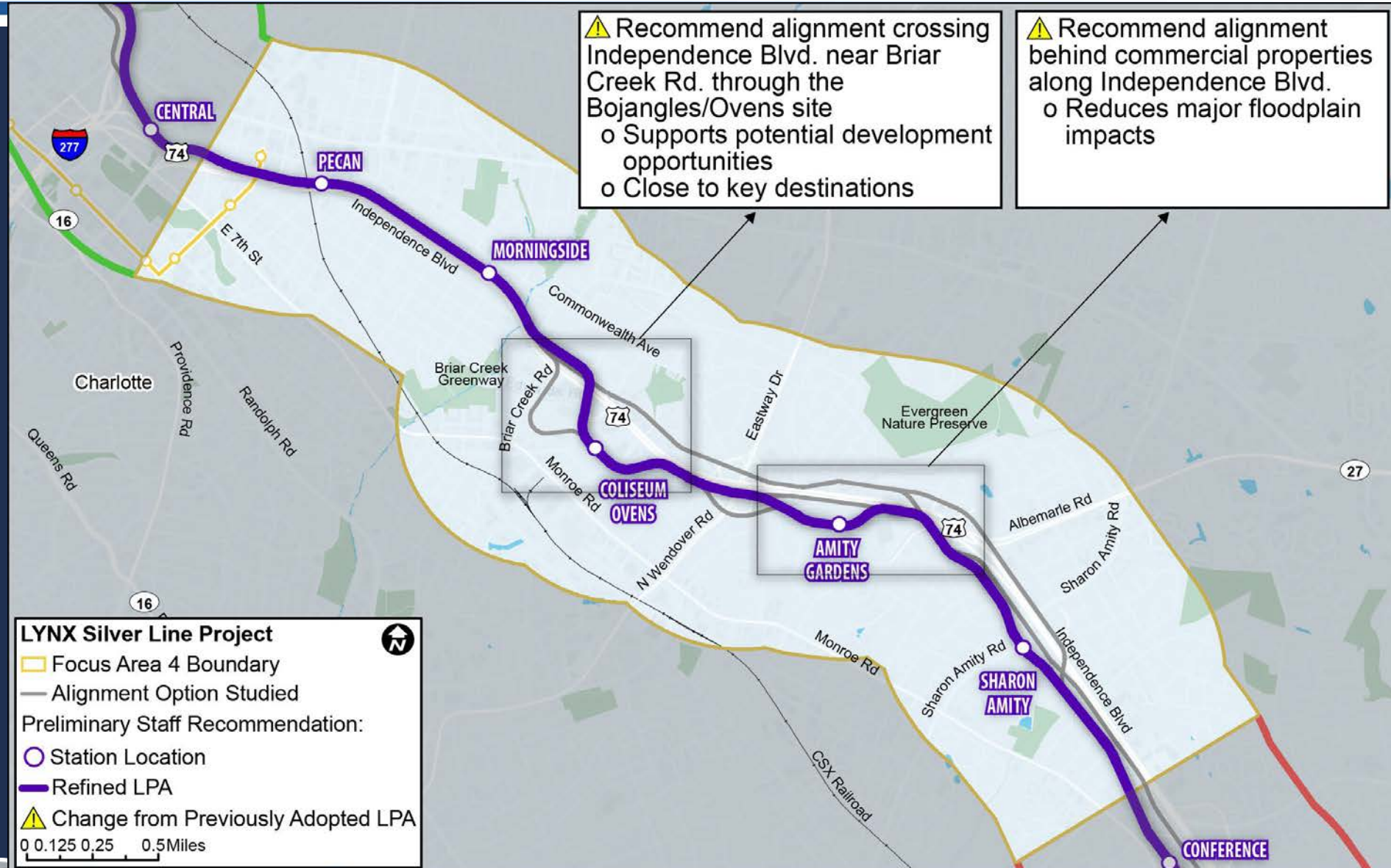

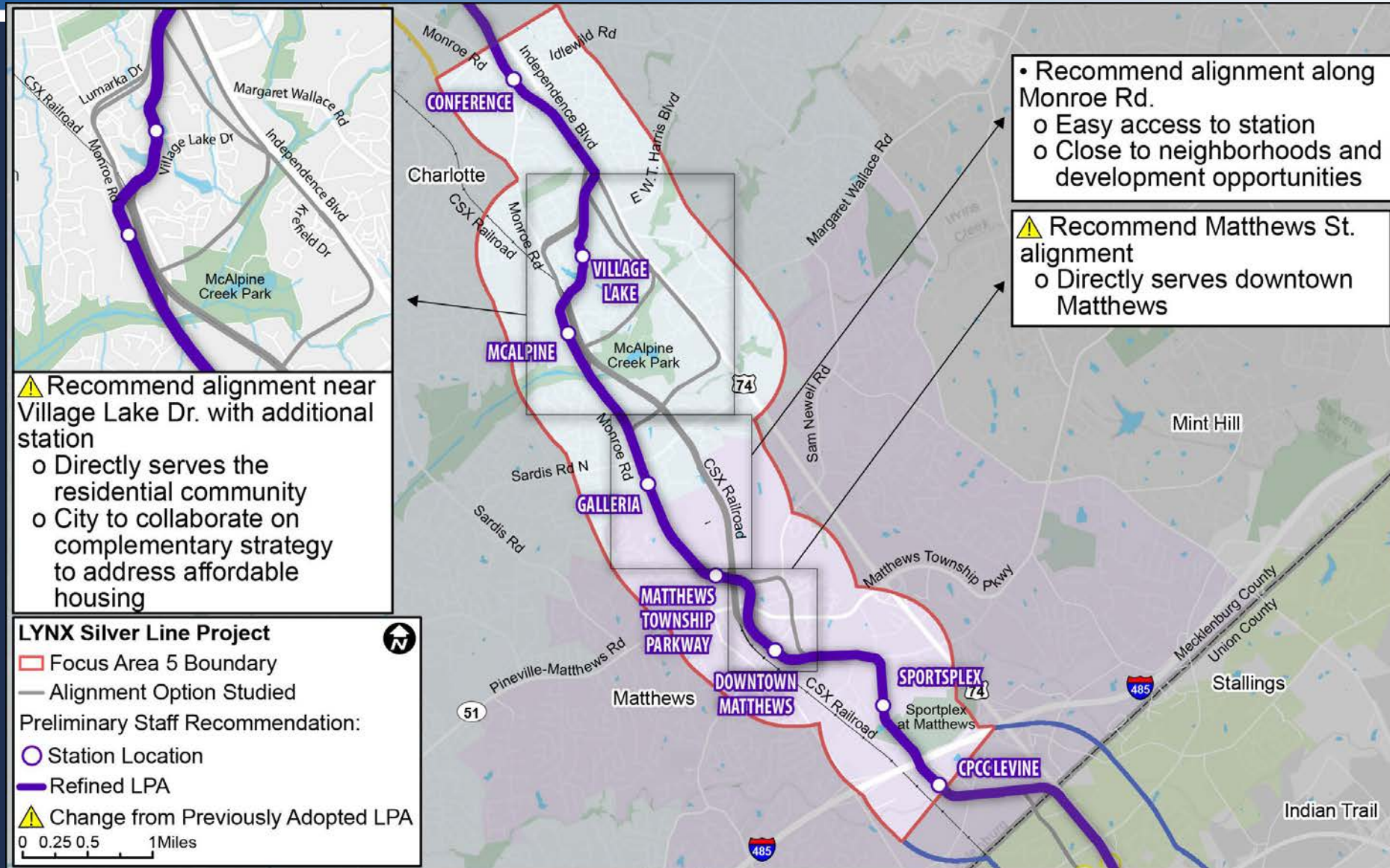

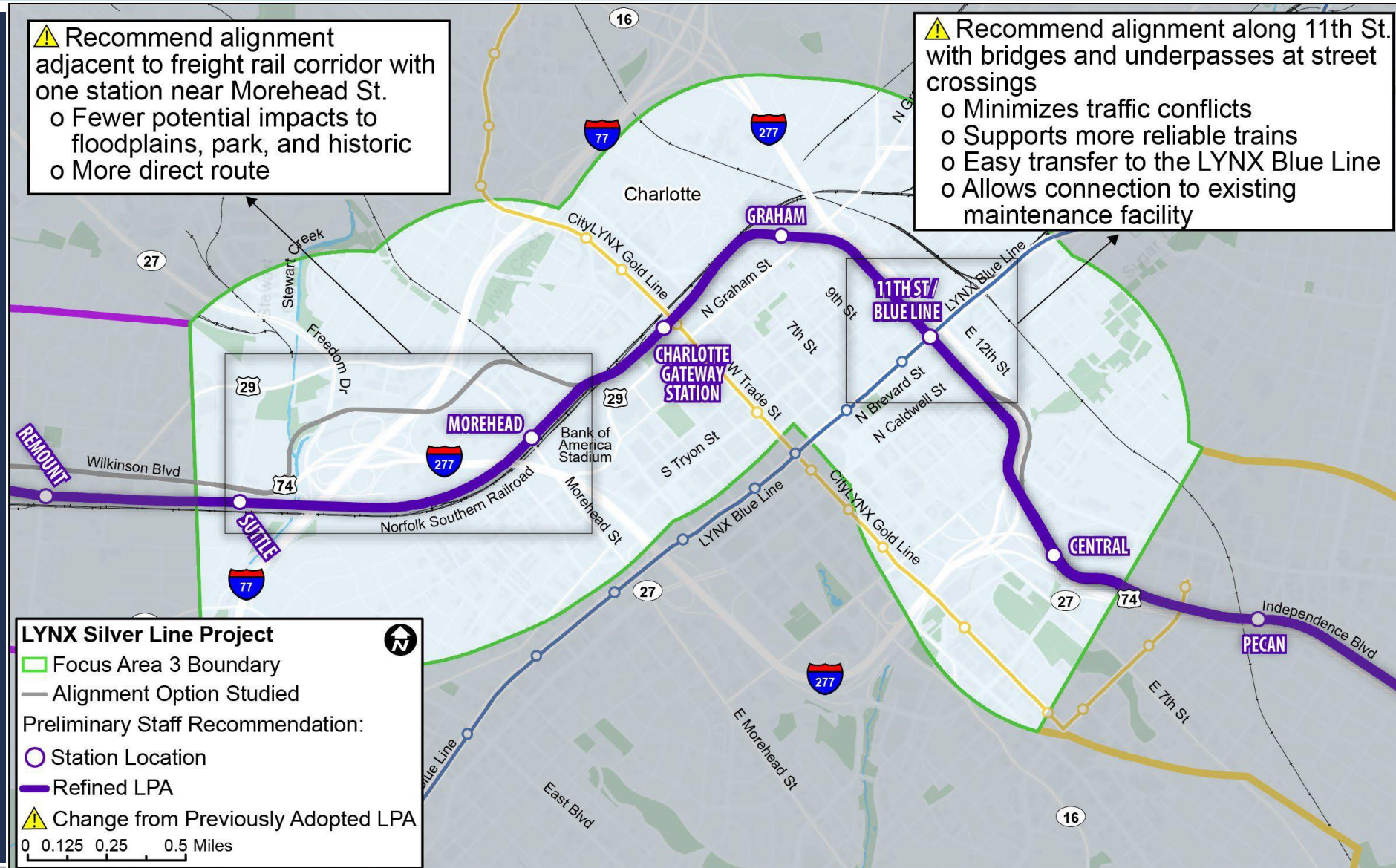

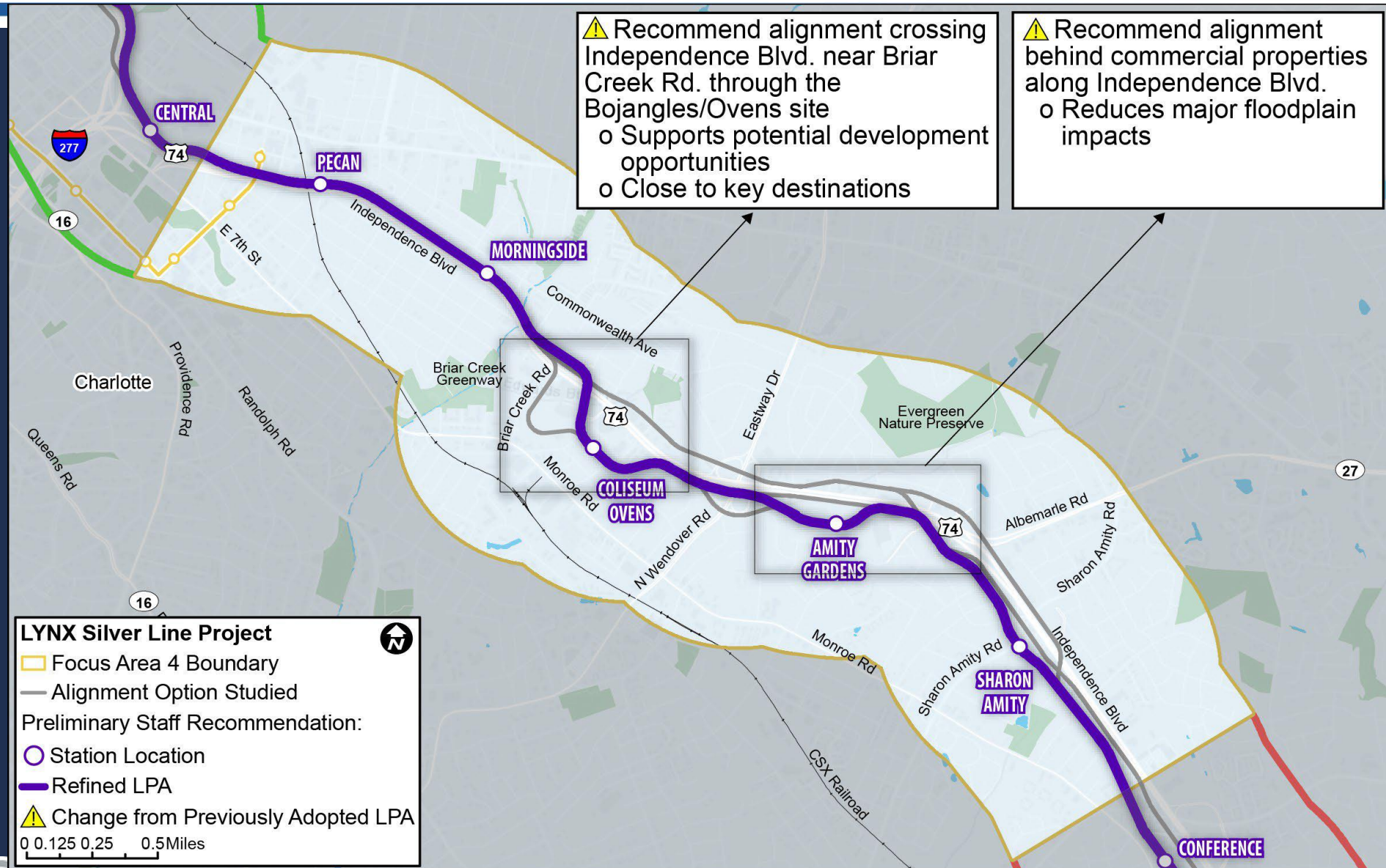
Preliminary Staff Recommendation : Focus Area 2



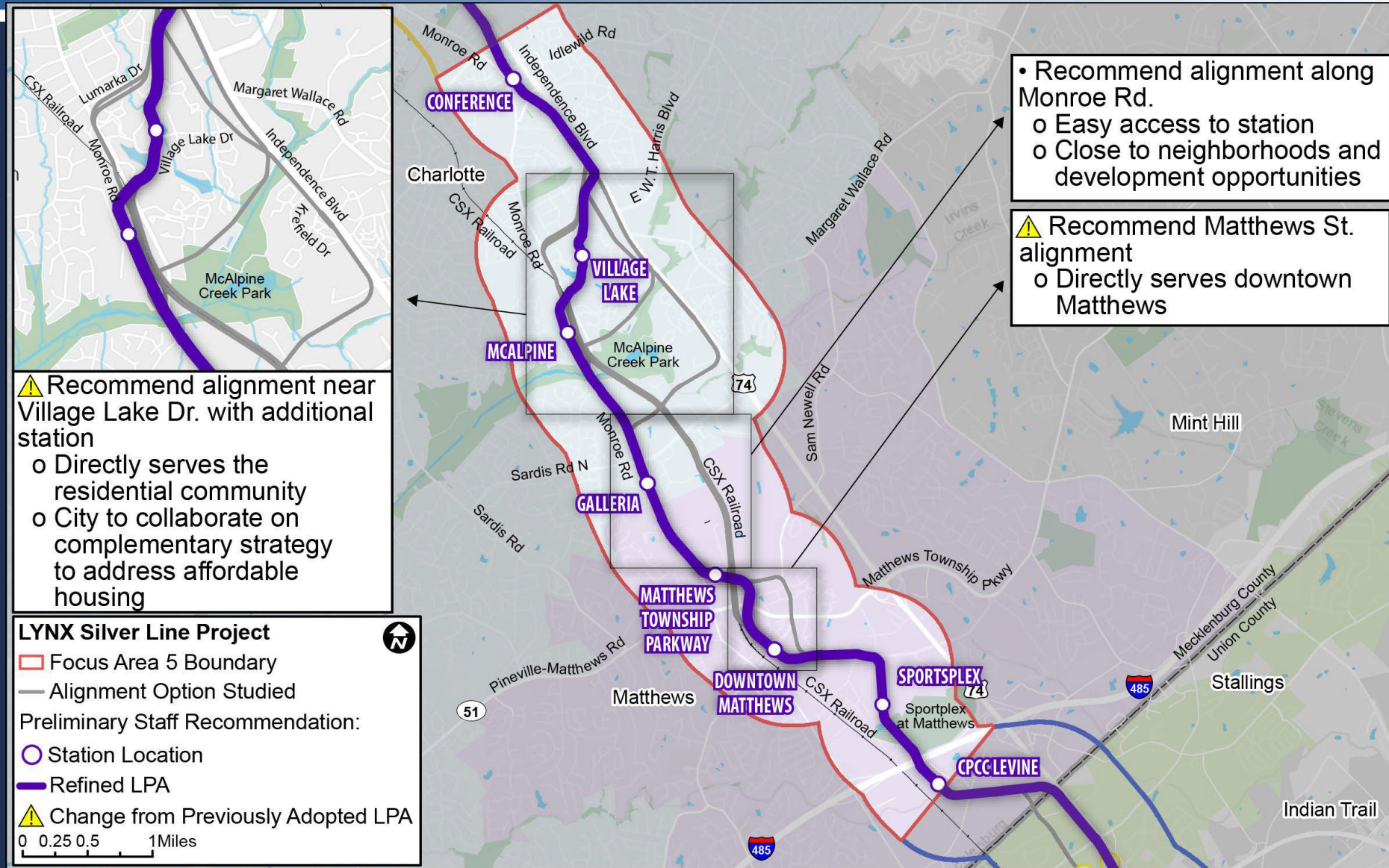
